

## Artist of the Month

If the entire display area is not being used for a LAA theme show, the wall opposite the regular monthly display will feature a specific artist or artists chosen by the LAA Board.

### **Application Requirements:**

Biography of 200-300 words

- 1.) Two digital images of the artist's work. Digital images must be "JPG" format, a minimum 8x5 (landscape) or 5x8 (portrait) length and width independent of each other and at 300 ppi resolution. Total file size should be between 800 K and 2 MB.
- 2.) Coordinators will assist artists with issues relating to digital images. Please contact them if you have any questions or need guidance.

### **Requirements to be AOM:**

- 1) Member of LAA for at least one year.
- 2) Has not exhibited at Plantation Club Gallery for over two years.
- 3) Adequate number of art works, properly framed.
- 4) Precedence will be given to those who have never been Artist of the Month.
- 5) Artists are encouraged to exhibit in two's or three's if applications exceed space.
- 6) All regulations about hanging on the member wall apply to AOM except size and delivery times. These will be agreed upon with Fran Leighton, the chairperson.

### **LAA Commitment to AOM:**

- 1) Opening Monthly Reception at the Plantation Club, usually the second Friday from 5-6 PM, which allows time for the Journal to be distributed.. LAA will provide a Fruit and Cheese Plate along with member and cash bar.
- 2) Appropriate Advertising in island publications, the TWATL, the Skinnie, the Journal, the Clubline, the Club E mail "Club Events?" on the Crawl, and on Gate Signs.
