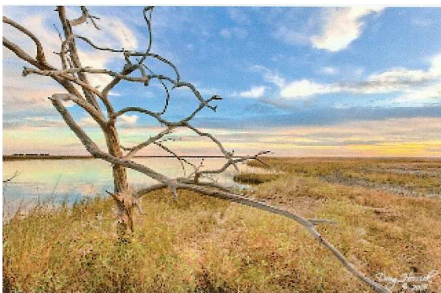

## Artist of the Month

**Doug Herrick**

**Plantation Club, January 2010  
Reception, Thurs., Jan 14**



The Landings Art Association ushers in the New Year with a display of photography by Artist

of the Month Doug Herrick. The monthly exhibition and sale at the Plantation Club Gallery runs from January 6 through February 3, 2010 and also include works in a variety of media by other Landings Art Association members.

With no formal training in the art of photography, Herrick's impressive work has been featured on the covers of various magazines and he is a frequent exhibitor in local art shows. He has found Low Country landscapes and the architecture in and around Savannah to be particularly inspiring since arriving here from his native Massachusetts in 2005.

“It feels natural to carry a camera,” he says. While growing up, family events and vacations were always recorded either by his Dad, or his "Auntie Mame". These were the formative years that encouraged what would evolve to be an art form through which to express his unique view of the world.

It was while serving as a young soldier stationed overseas that Herrick acquired his first Single Lens Reflex camera - an all-black professional model. He continued to use this camera until the digital age arrived. “My dreams had come true!” There was no more need for the inconvenience of film and developing.

Herrick's extensive experience as a printer has provided the technical understanding necessary to produce what is known as High Dynamic Range Imaging. Through his lens, he presents us with a variety of moods achieved through his personal interpretation of expansive space, texture, subtle coloration, and exceptional detail.

An opening reception, honoring January Artist of the Month Doug Herrick, will be held on **Thursday, January 14, from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m.** The reception includes a Members' Bar with cheese and fruit buffet courtesy of the Landings Art Association.
